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
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
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
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




### HISTORY




- located in the west of the island of La Palma, in the Aridane Valley

- the flamenco panel of the Patroness of the municipality, the Virgin de los Remedios










## Benahoarita Archeological Museum

- dedicated to the Benahoarita culture, the island's aboriginal people - "benahoaritas"
- a permanent exhibition on the habitat, lifestyle, industries and culture of these inhabitants






El gofio fue uno de los alimentos esenciales di los benañoaritas. Se obtenía mediante el tostado y la trituración de los cereales y sobre todo, segúr J. Abreu Gallindo, "....el mantenimiento que usaba en lugar de pan eran risicas de helechos y grano de amagante...". El uso de la raiz de helecho para hacer gofio se mantuvo hasta la dicada de los 60 del siglo XX. Por el contrario, parece poco faccibie el uso de los granos de amagantes para hacer gofio dado su reducido tamaño y la escasa cantidad de harina que pocilian aportar.

El gofio se podía comer solo, mezciado con agua, teche, miel, etc. Además, aprovecharian otro tipo de semillas silvestres (balangos, certillas, etc) que también se podían molturar y son abundantisimas por toda la orografía insular. La importancia de esta vianda queda corroborada por la gran cantidad de molinos de mano de basalto operad que apraepore se la supras de hibitación. Golfo was one of the assertial food lamp of the Benahoan proopie. It was made by grinding up and toasting cereal, especially, according to a form Galledo, ". "The sustement with they said cannot of bread even from code and not-hose grain. " The use of ferm roots to make golfo continued up unit the 1960s. The use of not-hose grain for making golfo, on the other hand, does not seem very lessible, given the other hand, does not seem very lessible, given their bread size and the small amount of four that it could give.

Offic could be eaten on its own, mised with water, milk, honey, etc. They would also use other kinds of wild seeds balls, yes, etc., which could see be ground and which are highly abundant all ower the island. The importance of this food is compostated by the large number of porous, baself hand greeding stores that appear in the dwelling alless.









